## DON'T MISS THIS FILM!



The Adult Formation Committee will be showing the film **13<sup>th</sup>**, the Oscar winning documentary directed by Ava DuVernay (director of Selma, and A Wrinkle in Time). The viewing will take place on **Thursday, June 28, 6:30-9:00 PM, Fireside Room**. This event is open to everyone.

The film is a reference to the 13<sup>th</sup> Amendment of the U.S. Constitution which freed slaves and prohibited slavery. The film explores the history of forced labor of blacks after the Civil War. It explains the system of convict leasing, lynching, and the Jim Crow laws that kept blacks in bondage. In more recent times, it looks at our evolving drug policies that has led to mass incarceration. It is a strong critique of the criminal justice system.

This presentation was strongly recommended by those who read the Bryan Stevenson book, **Just Mercy** last Fall as a way to promote and learn more about the criminal justice system in this country. We feel confident that this will be a thought provoking evening. Discussion and feedback will follow the film. Please attend and support the social justice work of our parish and community.
