Profession of Faith: (*Nicene Creed*)

We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, of all that is seen and unseen. MONDAY EVENING LENTEN DISCUSSION GROUP

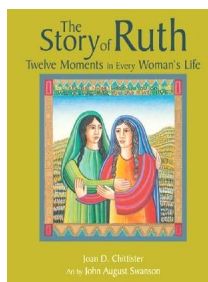
