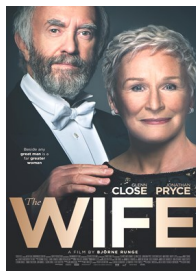

UPDATE



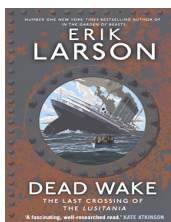
