Our Bishop Francis Krebs and the ELCA local Bishop Jim Gonia will be joining together in worship and signing a document to more formalize this partnership. **Everyone is invited to be part of this worship service on Wednesday, Oct 30 at 7:00pm in Denver at St. Paul (ECC) Church.** Fr. Teri has a copy of the document that is going to be signed which brings us together liturgically in a new way. This document does not bring us into full communion together, but it puts into words and understanding some of the liturgy sharing that has already been happening here in our building, and other locations in Colorado where ECC

communities are nested within ELCA Lutheran communities. Light of Christ and Bethlehem Lutheran have been part of the discussions and prayer leading up to this moment, and have been influential in the document that was created. By signing this document, our bishops are celebrating the collaboration that is already happening in communities like Light of Christ and Bethlehem Lutheran, and acknowledging the Holy Spirit's guidance in bringing Catholics and Lutherans together at God's Table. **St. Paul is located at 1600 Grant Street in Denver.
