Bring your friends and family! So bundle up meet us outside at the stable in the north parking lot to share this experience. All are welcome!

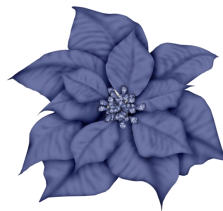
CHRISTMAS EVE CHOIR PRACTICES

POINSETTIAS FOR THE SANCTUARY

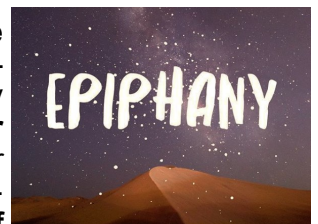
