29th to protect one another and our loved ones. We will re-evaluate at that time how to move forward. There will be no Masses, no meetings, and no gatherings for Light of Christ during this time. Please check your e-mail regularly, as we will be sharing information with you through the all parish distribution list. If you know someone who isn't on the list, have them call the church office and we will get them added.

Please follow your local public health recommendations and recommendations of your health insurance for what is best for you when we reopen.

Here are some other things to know related to church: Mass will be at 5pm the next three Saturdays (March 14, March 21 and March 28) on our Facebook page using Facebook live. When Mass is over, it will stay on our Facebook page as a video so you can go to our page and watch it whenever is a good time for you. Even if you are not on Facebook, you can go to our website www.lightofchristecc.org and select the Facebook logo (it looks like a fancy F, and as it take you to our page you can select the "Not Join At This Time" option). This will take you to our Facebook page where you can scroll through and watch Mass. We suggest you try these things now to see how they work. Call the church office with questions. The number here is 303-772-3785. Leave a message if we don't answer. We are checking the messages frequently.

We will also use the voice recorder to record the entire Mass, and then post the recording in the Homilies section of this website, under the "Homilies" tab.

Fr. Teri continues to be available for care. You may call or text her directly on her cell phone. If you don't have her cell phone number, you can call the office and get it from there.

We are Light of Christ. Let us live boldly together in our separate corners of the world as that Light, loving and serving God as we love and serve in God's world. Amen.
