We will be praying for the entire Light of Christ community on Saturday evening as we experience God’s grace together in our homes.
- **Online Advent Retreat** ~ Our Advent theme this year is Light of Christ in the Streets. We will be offering an daily Online Advent Retreat working with this theme. If you are currently receiving the weekly retreats from Fr. Teri, you are already signed up for the Advent retreat and there is nothing else for you to do. 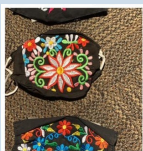
