As we receive the grace of reconciliation and healing at liturgy this weekend, may we re-

member that God's light lives in us and illuminates the world through us.

Here's what's happening these days at LOC:

- **For Adults: Art Meditation on Zoom** ~ All LOC adults are invited to join us for an evening of art and meditation on Wednesday evening, November 11th at 7:00pm. LOC member and art teacher Heather Brubaker will lead us in a new art meditation technique: Zentangle. All you need is a piece of paper, or a blank page in your journal, and a pen or marker. That's right, no particular art experience is required. Zentangle uses repetitive simple patterns to create a final project that is meditative in the process. At the end of our time together, Fr. Teri will lead us in a guided meditation with our newly created Zentangles for an evening of refreshment and connection. If you have any questions contact Heather or Fr. Teri. - **11th Hour Bell Ringing for Climate Justice** ~ At the 11th hour on the 11th day each month, the Adult Formation Team prays together and rings the church bell to raise awareness for climate justice. Join us at the church bell tower tomorrow Wednesday, November 11th, at 11am as we draw attention to this crucial justice issue and inspire renewed passion to our universal call to care for God's creation. This month's bell-ringing will also include a prayer and remembrance of both Armistice Day and Veterans' Day. We will be streaming this event live on our LOC Facebook page for those who cannot join us in-person.
- **Online Advent Retreat** ~ Our Advent theme this year is Light of Christ in the Streets. We will be offering an daily Online Advent Retreat working with this theme. If you are currently receiving the weekly retreats from Fr. Teri, you are already signed up for the Advent retreat and there is nothing else for you to do. You will receive the first installment of the Online Advent Daily Retreat on Saturday November 28th. Each day you will have the opportunity to explore three different offerings. A hard copy of the entire retreat can be provided to anyone who does not have reliable access to the internet, just let Fr. Teri know if that resource would be helpful.
- **Thanksgiving** ~ Fr. Teri and Pastor Katie will be sharing a Thanksgiving blessing, reflection, and prayer on Wednesday evening November 25th on the Bethlehem Lutheran YouTube channel. There will be a tablecloth blessing as part of the service, and everyone is invited to have their Thanksgiving day table cloth, place mats, napkins, or other items nearby at home for this blessing. We will let you know more specific information as it becomes available. Please check your bulletin on the 24th for the best information.

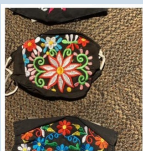
