- **Join Fr. Teri and Pastor Katie, and BL intern Joy, for Wednesday Midweek Prayer in Lent.** Each week they will build on the theme “Look what God can do with Dirt/Dust”. Wednesday, March 17th at 7PM. [link](#).
- **Communion and Palm Porch Drop!** Our next Porch Drop is Sunday March 21st, weather permitting. We will consecrate enough hosts for everyone to have some at home if you live locally, and for this Porch Drop we will have Palms to get ready for Holy Week and Palm Saturday (March 27th). If you have received a Porch Drop in the past, you are already on the list. But if you would like to start receiving, please let Fr. Teri know via e-mail (pastor@lightofchristecc.org) by Wednesday March 17th. Please note how many people you need Communion for, and if you need gluten-free. Someone will contact you to make arrangements to drop off on March 21st. You will create a small sacred space at home to keep the Communion Hosts, and they will last you several weeks, even longer if you break them in half. We anticipate the next Porch Drop to take place in May or June. Talk to Fr. Teri if you have any questions.
- **Easter Vigil Signup** - This year, we will be hosting an in-person Easter Vigil in the parking lot on Saturday, April 3 at 5PM. As with previous parking lot services, this will include a “bring your own bread” communion. We are pleased to offer limited space for socially distanced families to sit together for those who wish to have an in-person option as well as our more traditional, in-car service.

Both options are opt-in, so please complete the sign up linked [here](#) by March 27, so we can best plan how to accommodate everyone and comply with COVID restrictions/contact tracing.

As usual, we will also be broadcasting the celebration on Facebook live for those who cannot attend in person.
